



## ANNOUNCEMENT OF PATHUMWILAI SCHOOL

### Subject: Recruitment of a Foreign Teacher for Science

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Pathumwilai School is seeking to recruit a qualified individual to be employed as a temporary teacher under the Intensive Academic Program to teach Science, for one position.

The recruitment follows the rules, procedures, and conditions for hiring temporary monthly employees funded by resource contributions. The details are as follows:

#### 1. Position: Science Teacher

Responsibilities:

1.1 Teach Science to students in the Mini English Program.

1.2 Supervise and maintain student discipline.

1.3 Support school policies and operations.

1.4 Perform other duties as assigned by the school administration.

1.5 Salary: 27,500–30,000 Baht/month, with 5% social security contribution (half paid by the school).

1.6 Contract period: From the start date until March 31, 2027 (renewable annually).

#### 2. Qualifications

Applicants must meet the following requirements:

2.1 Be a foreign teacher who is a native speaker from one of the following countries: United Kingdom, United States, Canada, Australia, or New Zealand; or from countries where English is used as a second language, such as South Africa, the Netherlands, France, the Philippines, etc.

2.2 Age between 22–40 years ...

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2.3 Hold at least a Bachelor's degree or equivalent and possess a teaching license, or be in the process of obtaining one in accordance with the Teachers Council of Thailand regulations.

2.4 Have completed required training or received permission/exemption according to the Teachers Council regulations.

2.5 Be able to perform additional duties assigned by the school, such as homeroom teacher, exam proctor, or English competition staff.

2.6 Be able to teach extra hours and participate in school activities, such as providing training for teachers or welcoming students at the school gate once a week.

2.7 Be responsible, dedicated, hardworking, polite, and patient.

2.8 Be able to create and develop instructional materials.

2.9 Work during official hours (07:30–16:30), equivalent to full-time teachers, and sign in/out daily.

2.10 Be willing to assist in special school activities, including those held on weekends or public holidays.

2.11 Have knowledge of Thai culture and other cultures and be able to adapt appropriately.
